**POLL RESULTS OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING
HELD ON 14 SEPTEMBER 2026**

The board of directors (the “**Directors**” and the “**Board**”, respectively) of Allied Sustainability and Environmental Consultants Group Limited (the “**Company**”) is pleased to announce that all the proposed resolutions as set out in the notice of the annual general meeting of the Company dated 21 August 2026 (the “**AGM Notice**” and the “**Proposed Resolutions**”, respectively) were duly passed by the holders of the Company’s ordinary shares of HK\$0.02 each (the “**Shares**” and the “**Shareholders**”, respectively) by way of poll at the annual general meeting of the Company held on Monday, 14 September 2026 (the “**2026 AGM**”). Unless otherwise defined, capitalized terms used in this announcement shall have the same meanings as those defined in the AGM Notice.

As at the date of the 2026 AGM, there were 733,190,000 issued Shares (excluding treasury shares) entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote for or against the Proposed Resolutions at the 2026 AGM. The Shareholders in attendance either in person or by proxy at the 2026 AGM held a total of 365,233,278 Shares, representing approximately 49.8% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares) as of the date of the 2026 AGM. There were no Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and abstain from voting in favour of the Proposed Resolutions at the 2026 AGM as set out in Rule 17.47A of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on GEM of the Stock Exchange (the “**GEM**” and the “**GEM Listing Rules**”, respectively). The Company had 4,320,000 treasury shares and confirms that it did not vote with the treasury shares.

None of the Shareholders were required under the GEM Listing Rules to abstain from voting on the Proposed Resolutions at the 2026 AGM. None of the Shareholders have stated in the Company's circular dated 21 August 2026 (the "**Circular**") their intention to vote against or to abstain from voting on any of the Proposed Resolutions at the 2026 AGM.

Tricor Investor Services Limited, the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, was appointed and acted as the scrutineer for the vote-taking at the 2026 AGM.

Ms. Kwok May Han Grace and Mr. Li Wing Sum Steven attended the 2026 AGM in person while Mr. Wu Dennis Pak Kit, Ms. Wong Yee Lin Elaine and Ms. Lam Ka Lai attended the 2026 AGM by electronic means.
